Summary of Gender Based Violence Level 2 training

This training, developed with input from local specialist services, equips frontline workers with the knowledge to respond effectively to gender-based violence (GBV), strengthening referral pathways to support. Participants will gain a deeper understanding of the impact of GBV in all its forms, while also learning practical strategies for supporting survivors and handling disclosures. The course highlights local and national statistics and focusses on improving service coordination, aligning with Scotland's Equally Safe strategy. This ensures that survivors of GBV in Shetland receive the best possible support from an informed and collaborative network.
